**JULY 9, 2021** 

The Board of County Commissioners of Delaware County met in Special Session at 9:00 a.m. on July 9, 2021. The agenda was posted July 7, 2021 at 9:00 a.m. and placed in the kiosk located on the courthouse lawn as well as the county website. Members of the Board present were Commissioner David Poindexter-Chairman and Commissioner Jake Callihan-Member (Commissioner Martin Kirk was absent) and County Clerk Barbara Barnes-Secretary. ## Flag Salute - Roll Call and Call to Order

AGENDA #1- A motion was made by Commissioner Callihan and seconded by Commissioner Poindexter to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting dated July 6, 2021. Roll call: Commissioner Poindexter-yes and Commissioner Callihan-yes. Motion carried.
