



DELAWARE COUNTY COMMISSIONER'S MEETING MINUTES

April 23, 2026

The Board of County Commissioners of Delaware County met in Special Session at 2 p.m. on April 23, 2026. The agenda was posted April 21, 2026, at 9:15 a.m. and placed in the kiosk on the courthouse lawn as well as the county website. Members of the Board present were Commissioner David Poindexter-Chairman, Commissioner David Beck-Member and County Clerk Barbara Barnes -Secretary. The Board of Delaware County Commissioners is hereby authorized to act on the following items:

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Poindexter followed by the flag salute and roll call. Commissioner Callihan was absent.

AGENDA #1 - A motion was made by Commissioner Beck and seconded by Commissioner Poindexter to determine that notice of meeting and agenda for this meeting was properly posted in accordance with the Oklahoma Open Meeting Act. Roll call: Commissioner Poindexter-yes; Commissioner Beck-yes. Motion carried.

AGENDA #2- A motion was made by Commissioner Beck and seconded by Commissioner Poindexter to advertise for sealed bids on annual election ballots. Persons interested in submitting a bid are to contact Michael Baker, P.A., located in the County Clerk's Office, Jay, Okla. Bids will be opened and reviewed May 19, 2026, at 9 a.m. with possible acceptance. Bids will be received no later than 3 p.m. in the County Clerk's Office on May 15, 2026. Board reserves the right to accept/reject any and all bids and the right to re-advertise. County Bid #25-26/15. Roll call: Commissioner Poindexter-yes; and Commissioner Beck-yes. Motion carried.

AGENDA #3- A motion was made by Commissioner Beck and seconded by Commissioner Poindexter to discuss with possible action purchase of a 2026 F-250 pickup in the amount of \$63,192.75 from Confidence Ford on state bid contract #SW0035 for Delaware County Emergency Management. Roll call: Commissioner Poindexter-yes; and Commissioner Beck-yes. Motion carried. Emergency Management Director Jeff Reeves said the newest truck his department has is five years old with approximately 75,000 miles. He said the two old pickups were surplus due to wear. Beck asked what this truck will be used for. Reeves said this will be his daily driver and the one he uses now will be turned over to Deputy Director Chris Wilkins. Reeves said Emergency Management has one other truck which is a ¾ ton with over 100,000 miles. Beck asked if there is money for this purchase. Poindexter said the contingency account has sufficient funds to complete the fiscal year. Neither Poindexter nor Barnes could state the amount of funds available in the Use Tax account. Reeves said the \$165,000 reimbursement for the new command center trailer will be arriving soon. This is a grant reimbursement. A motion was made by Poindexter and seconded by Beck to purchase the pickup in the amount of \$63,192.75 from Confidence Ford. Roll call: Commissioner Poindexter-yes; and Commissioner Beck-yes. Motion carried. The money will come from the Use Tax account.

AGENDA #5- A motion was made by Commissioner Beck and seconded by Commissioner Poindexter to approve payment of claims submitted by the county clerk's office. Roll call: Commissioner Poindexter-yes; and Commissioner Beck-yes. Motion carried.

AGENDA #5- A motion was made by Commissioner Beck and seconded by Commissioner Poindexter to adjourn at 2:10 p.m. Roll call: Commissioner Poindexter-yes; and Commissioner Beck-yes. Motion carried.
