The HR Director and the EM Director are working together on continuing safety measures as well as looking at what might qualify for FEMA or CARES Act reimbursement. The County Clerk's office continues to work from 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 Mon – Thurs without taking lunches or breaks. The County Clerk's office is working remotely on Friday. The Treasurer's office is working from 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 Mon – Thurs without taking lunches or breaks. The Court Clerk and the DA's office is working Mon-Fri 8:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.
