AGENDA #7- A motion was made by Commissioner Kirk and seconded by Commissioner Poindexter to approve to hear a presentation by Vicki Cossairt, Human Resources Director, updating current events in Human Resources Department with possible action concerning HSA and HRA Accounts for employees for calendar year 2019. Cossairt reported to the board that approximately 97 people were eligible for the Health Savings Account (HSA) card and that there were 3 people 65 years or older that would qualify for Health Reimbursement Account (HRA). Also, one employee is eligible for benefits, but is classified part time because of going over the threshold of full-time hours. Cossairt said that the county spends \$490 per employee on benefits. Cossairt wanted to clarify whether an employee choosing an insurance plan other that the High Deductible Plan would pay the difference between \$401.78. Cossairt stated that only one person has chosen a different plan than the High Deductible. County Clerk Barbara Barnes said that she understood the county had agreed to pay \$490.00 if an alternative plan was chosen by an employee. Chairman Martin said the county had budgeted \$490.00 per employee. Cossairt said that the plan had not been presented this way, but the decision was up to the board. Chairman Martin said he was fine with the \$490 that had been budgeted. Roll call: Commissioner Martin-yes, Commissioner Kirk-yes, Commissioner Poindexter-yes. Motion carried.

AGENDA #8- A motion was not needed to approve lease purchase agreement for one pre-owned pumper truck between Cowskin Fire Department and Jon's Mid-America Fire Apparatus with assignment to Welch State Bank.
