Vicki Cossairt, HR Director, reported that cases continue to increase with 506 diagnosed cases, up 33 from last week, 20 deaths, 424 recovered, up by 36 and 62 active cases, down by 3. The hours of the courthouse offices are unchanged from last week with rotating staffs except for the County Clerk that does not have enough staff to rotate. Lunches are not taken because there is not enough space to social distance. The courthouse is still being sanitized each Friday and common areas and restrooms cleaned several times a day by maintenance. Cossairt reminded those employees that work outside in the heat to be sure and stay hydrated.

Wright said that he is a retired medic from the Air Force and is also a nurse. After retiring from the military, he worked for a drug testing company until his second retirement. He has started his drug testing business in Jay and is able to provide pre-employment testing, random testing, post-accident testing, breath alcohol testing, as well as DOT testing. He also stated that he uses certified labs. Sheriff Harlan Moore questioned the turnaround for pre-employment drug testing and Wright stated it is usually 2 days. Wright would like to provide services for the county and will present a contract for consideration by the BOCC.
