AGENDA #6-A motion was made by Commissioner Martin and seconded by Commissioner Kirk to approve Hearing Human Resources Vici Cossairt on current status regarding families first Coronavirus. Roll Call: Commissioner Poindexter-yes Commissioner Martin-yes Commissioner Kirk-yes. Motion carried. Vicki Cossairt, HR Director, reported that cases continue to increase with 638 diagnosed cases, up 48 from last week, 23 deaths up 1 from last week, 530 recovered, up by 37 and 85 active cases, up by 10. Statistical data for age groups for highest cases of COVID -18-35; 36-49; 50-64; 65 and up; 5-17; 0-4. / 17 of the deaths were in Grove, 1 in Jay, and 1 in Kansas the rest throughout the county. Commissioner Poindexter questioned the increase in cases as well as any data that pertained to why the two age groups were the highest? The increase in cases and deaths could be attributed to increased interaction resulting from holiday activities as well as a relaxed attitude regarding mask wearing and social distancing surrounding shopping, restaurants and after school activities with a large concentration of the ages 18-49. Reminder for Flu Shots with Flu season approaching as well as encouragement to review mental health resources available if needed. The hours of the courthouse offices are unchanged from last week with rotating staffs except for the County Clerk that does not have enough staff to rotate.

AGENDA #7-A motion was made by Commissioner Kirk and seconded by Commissioner Martin to approve to discuss and review the County's Policies in relation to COVID-19 and take action to modify those policies as needed. Continuing to stay as safe as possible and still functioning with social distancing and mask wearing.
