RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, in Oklahoma, County Commissioners may set speed limits for county roads;

WHEREAS, Oklahoma Statute Title 47-11 says the Board of County Commissioners may determine, by resolution, the maximum speed limit which shall apply to all county roads not otherwise posted for speed;


WHEREAS, the District #3 County Commissioner has determined the speed limits need to be posted on portions of some roads in his care;

NOW, THEREFORE, the following speed limits will be posted in Delaware County District #3:


- A maximum Speed Limit of 30 MPH starting at the intersection with US 412 and extending to the intersection of S 660 Road and S 568 Road.
- A maximum Speed Limit of 35 MPH starting at the intersection of S 660 Road and S 568 Road and extending to the intersection of S 660 Road and S 661 Road.
- Pedestrian Crossing signs will be placed at the recreation area north of US 412 and Winding Road Advisory Signs will be placed at the ends of the winding sections of the roadway.
- A maximum Speed Limit of 35 MPH starting approximately 200 feet south of the intersection of S 700 Road and E 555 Road and extending north to the intersection of S 700 Road and E 540 Road.
- Turn Advisory Signs with an Advisory Speed of 20 MPH will be used at the intersection of S 700 Road and E 530 Road and the intersection of S 690 Road and E 530 Road
